NOTICE TO THE COMMUNITY – June 21, 2021

We are continuing to track the COVID-19 situation locally as well as regionally. We have been watching the numbers steadily decrease as we are on the downside of the third wave. We have had 4 vaccine clinics in the community, including giving doses to our 12 – 17 yr olds. We also have a clinic on June 24 for the second dose of Moderna and those who would like a first dose of the vaccine as well.

We know that this virus can be tricky and requires us to continue with the public health measures of wearing a mask, maintaining a distance of 6 feet and washing our hands often. We are doing our best to balance the hardships of the public health measures of requiring self-isolation & rapid testing with the risk that remains out there.

We are changing the requirement of the self-isolation & rapid testing. They will remain in place for those who travel outside of Northern Ontario (south of Parry Sound) as well as travel to problem areas, such as Porcupine Health Unit.
