NOTICE TO THE COMMUNITY – May 26, 2021

We are continuing to monitor the situation regarding the current stay-at-home order enacted from the province as of April 2nd, 2021.

The province has released a 3-step plan for reopening, and we are currently evaluating what this means for Pic Mobert and our citizens. As of May 22nd, the province has made changes to the stay-at-home order, outdoor gatherings of 5 are now allowed with public health measures in places. Ontario will also allow more outdoor recreational amenities to open with restrictions.

The province will remain in each step for at least 21 days to evaluate any impacts on key public health and health system indicators. If at the end of the 21 days, the following vaccination thresholds have been met, along with positive trends in other key public health and health system indicators, then the province will move to the next step:

- **Step 1:** 60 per cent of adults vaccinated with one dose.
- **Step 2:** 70 per cent of adults vaccinated with one dose and 20 per cent vaccinated with two doses.
- **Step 3:** 70 to 80 per cent of adults vaccinated with one dose and 25 per cent vaccinated with two doses.

With the current rate the Ontario government anticipates entering Step 1 June 14, 2021. We will continue to monitor the provinces plan to lift the current stay at home order set to expire on June 2nd and communicate what that will mean for the community. In the meantime, miigwetch for your continued commitment to keeping yourself and the community safe.
